ROUTES AND RECEPTION CENTERS

Reception Centers are designated to allow residents who need to evacuate, and do not have family or friends to stay with or cannot obtain hotel rooms, to have a specific initial location to report to outside of the inundation area. Once evacuees report in to their designated Reception Center, as outlined below, they will be assigned a public shelter.

Residents with pets should bring their pets in carriers.

By reporting to the Reception Centers, officials will have time to get shelters opened and prepared. Although all of these reception centers are approved shelters, evacuees will be dispersed to shelters throughout the County, based on the number each will accommodate.

1. Residents living in the areas that lie north of Technology Parkway and the North Rome Connector and GA 1 Loop (Veterans Memorial Pkwy) which are west of the Oostanaula River should report to the **New Armuchee Baptist Church at 5385 Martha Berry Highway** for shelter assignment.
2. Residents living in the areas east of the Oostanaula River and west of Calhoun Road (then proceeding south on Calhoun Road), west of SR 53 (Calhoun Hwy), then west of US 27, SR20, SR 53 (Turner McCall Blvd) then north of the Etowah River should report to **New Antioch Baptist Church at 4553 Calhoun Road** for shelter assignment.
3. Residents living in the areas east-southeast of Calhoun Rd (then proceeding south on Calhoun Rd), east of SR 53 (Calhoun Hwy), then East of US 27, SR20, SR53 (Turner McCall Blvd), then north of the Etowah River should report to Johnson **Elementary School at 1910 Morrison Campground Road** for shelter assignment.
4. Residents living in the areas south of the Etowah River and east of GA 101 (East 2d Ave.), and East of US27, SR20,SR53 (Turner McCall Blvd), then East of US 27,SR53 (Cedartown Hwy) should report to **Hollywood Baptist Church at 112 Lombardy Way** for shelter assignment.
5. Residents living in the areas south of the Etowah River, and south and east of the Coosa River, and west of GA Hwy 101 (East 2d Ave), then west of US 27, GA20, GA53 (Turner McCall Blvd), then west of US27, SR53 (Cedartown Hwy) should report to the **First Baptist Church of Cave Spring at 4 Cedartown Street** for shelter assignment.
6. Residents living in the areas north of the Coosa River and south of GA Hwy 20 (Shorter Ave / Alabama Hwy), then west of GA why 101 (E.2nd Ave) should report to **Coosa High School at 4454 Alabama Hwy** for shelter assignment.

7. Residents living in the areas north of GA Hwy 20 (Shorter Ave/Alabama Hwy), then east of GA Hwy 101 (E 2nd Ave), then west of the Oostanaula River, and South of GA Hwy 1 Loop (Veterans Memorial Hwy), and south of the North Rome Connector, and south of Technology Parkway should report to **Garden Lakes Baptist Church at 2200 Redmond Circle** for shelter assignment.
